UNIT 6 - VIDEO EXERCISE

Objective:

To practice using a video camera, shooting different shots to create a single idea or narrative. Practice and familiarize yourself with Premiere pro to import video, edit shots and export video.

Project Overview/Process:

- Come up with a very basic narrative/One actions.
Example: person walks through a door; Getting in a car; going up the stairs; making a sandwich; getting a cup of coffee; washing your hands;

- Use an HD video recorder to **shot four different types of shots** (angles) as seen on this website

Or GOOGLE - Types of video shots

- Edit them together in Premiere Pro
- Export. MOV or MP4 - makes sure audio and video are check marked to export. Check source and output tabs to make sure they visually match. Make sure the output is HD 1920x1080
- Embed or link file on your page.

-Hard Drive
